

**Liquor Commission

Call to Order/Roll Call: In the absence of Chairperson Dan Foster, Community Development Director Martin Scott called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

Reading of Agenda – Additions – Deletions: The agenda was read and accepted. There were no changes.

Public Comment: None

Considerations:

1) Western Springs Business Association – Christkindl Market: Request for Class “J” license (Special Event on Village –Owned Property) for Saturday, December 2, 2017.

Mr. Scott gave a brief overview of the annual holiday event held on the Village Tower Green that includes music, food, a marketplace and other activities as well as the sale of alcohol, in this case a mulled wine called gluvine. Solstice Restaurant acted as the applicant for the permit. Commissioner McNeily made a motion to pass the license request and Commissioner Cronin seconded the motion. It passed unanimously. The proposal will now go to the Village Board for consideration.

2) Liquor Control Code – Proposed Amendments

Mr. Scott provided background on the code changes that will allow restaurants which serve liquor to also provide minor forms of entertainment which would include jukeboxes, internet music stations and limited video games. The liquor code prohibition on video gaming terminals would remain. Commissioner McNeily made a motion to approve the code changes and Commissioner Cronin seconded the motion. It was passed unanimously. The code changes will now go to the Village Board for consideration.

Approval of Minutes – June 6, 2017

There were no additions or deletions. Commissioner McNeily moved to approve the minutes and Commissioner Cronin seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Other Business: Mr. Scott said no applications are pending.

Adjournment: Commissioner Cronin made a motion to adjourn and Commissioner McNeily seconded the motion. By unanimous vote, the meeting was adjourned at 6:14 p.m.
