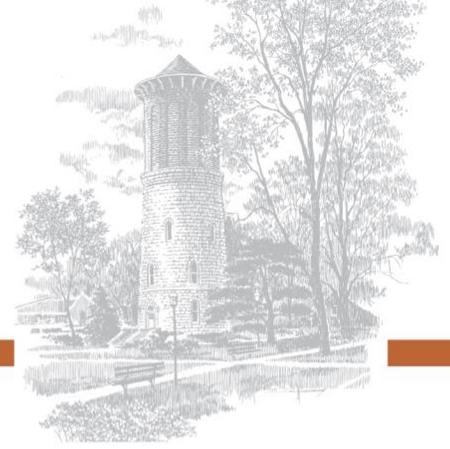

Refuse & Recycling Collection:

Grand Avenue Project in Ridgewood:

- The Village identified Grand Avenue, Lawn Drive to Linden Circle, as a concrete reconstruction project for 2021. Last month, a notice was mailed to affected residents, notifying them of public meeting about the proposed improvements via Zoom Webinar on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 from 6 – 7 pm. 47th Street Resurfacing Project:

- On September 14, IDOT will begin a resurfacing project on 47th Street, from County Line Road through Western Springs. One lane in each direction will be maintained during construction, with full road re-opening anticipated in the evenings. Partial sidewalk closures will occur.
