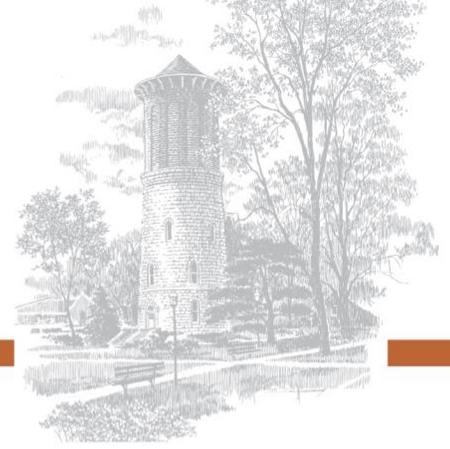

Halloween Guidelines:

- Halloween joins the long list of activities that will take place differently this year, due to COVID-19. The Center for Disease Control (CDC), the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), and the communities of Western Springs, La Grange, La Grange Park and Countryside have made [recommendations](#) for celebrating in ways that reduce the risk of transmission.

PACE Bus Route Discontinuation:

- At the October 21 meeting of the Pace Board of Directors, a proposed 2021 budget will be released that, while balanced and without fare increases, formalizes on-going service suspensions on 73 routes. Route 669 (Western Springs-Indian Head Park) is being proposed for permanent discontinuation.
