

Leaf Pickup:

2020 Modified Condition Pavement Index Report:

- The Department of Municipal Services has published the 2020 MPCl. Staff utilizes the outcomes of this review to plan future roadway projects. The map format is interactive and allows you to click on each roadway segment to view the ratings. The report is available on the [website](#).

Soil Boring Near Tollway:

- Starting the week of October 12 and continuing for several weeks, Tollway crews have soil borings planned in our area. This work will occur during the day, and is weather dependent.
